

Summer 2025 Sr. Ministry Intern

Position Description:

The goal of the summer ministry internship is to introduce candidates to various ministry opportunities. Interns will provide meaningful ministry to people of all ages in many different settings.

One week, our interns might be caring for babies in the nursery, while the next, they might be sitting across from an elderly saint in a local senior's home. A willingness to experience the full range of ministry opportunities is a must for Cornerstone summer interns. In addition to face-to-face ministry opportunities, the summer internship will also include a variety of administrative and audio/visual tasks.

Interns will be expected to plan, prepare, and present lessons to children and youth between the ages of 2 and 18. Training will also be provided to our interns so that they are comfortable and confident in overseeing a variety of technology-based tasks. This includes video shooting and editing, operating the church soundboard, and preparing sermon slides.

A major rock of the summer internship program is the church's weeklong day camp. Every intern will be involved in the planning and execution of this event. Under the oversight of the Children's Ministry Directors, interns will be responsible for every component of this camp.

The internship will also include two weekly meetings with the Intern Directors. One of these meetings will include all the summer interns for spiritual growth and community building. The second meeting will be a one-on-one meeting for internship evaluation and mentorship.

Position Details:

The Summer Ministry Internship is a sixteen-week program that runs from May 5th to August 22nd. Interns are expected to work 30- 40 hours per week at an hourly rate.
