• In light COVID-19 there have been challenges; Dr. Craig and Rene have had to reimagine and restructure their Mission to South Africa.


 The name has changed to ABWE South Africa Redevelopment Mission Project.



Interviewing and recruiting potential missionaries for working in Rural KwaZulu Natal part time or long term.






Dr. Craig working with Pastor Shadrack in obtaining and discussing daily-weekly updates of the Pastoral Benevolence recipients
