Summer 2024 Ministry Intern

Position Description:

The goal of the summer ministry internship is to introduce candidates to a wide variety of ministry opportunities. Interns will provide meaningful ministry to people of all ages in many different settings. One week might see our interns caring for babies in the nursery, while the next they might be sitting across from an elderly saint in a local senior's home. A willingness to experience the full gambit of ministry opportunities is a must for Cornerstone summer interns.

In addition to face-to-face ministry opportunities, the summer internship will also include a variety of administrative and audio/visual tasks. Interns will be expected to plan, prepare, and present lessons to children and youth between the ages of 2-18. Training will also be provided to our interns so that they are comfortable and confident in overseeing a variety of technology-based tasks. This includes such things as video shooting and editing, operating the church sound board, and preparing sermon slides.

A major rock of the summer internship program is the church's weeklong day-camp program. Every intern will be involved in the planning and execution of this event. Under the oversight of the Children's Ministry Directors, interns will be given responsibility over every component of this camp.

The internship will also include two weekly meetings with the Intern Directors. One of these meetings will include all the summer interns and will be for the purpose of spiritual growth and community building. The second meeting will be a one-on-one meeting for the purposes of internship evaluation and mentorship.

Position Details:

The Summer Ministry Internship is an eleven-week program that runs from May 06 to August 18. Interns are expected to work 40 hours per week at the remuneration rate of \$17/hr.
